### **Press Release**

#### **on License Revocation and Suspension of 17 Telecoms Operators**

The Ministry of Post and Telecommunications (MPTC) would like to announce to the general public that previously some telecoms operators failed to pay their revenue shares to the government, some were inactive and some reported false revenue figures. As such, MPTC tasked an inspection team to monitor and audit some of the existing telecoms operators to gather information on the status of their business operations, technical capacities and financial conditions. As a result, MPTC decided to suspend and/or revoke licenses of 17 telecoms operators, as listed in the table below. The inspection findings indicated that the 17 operators were operationally inactive, employee-less, or non-compliant to their revenue share and other obligations stated in their licenses or failed to provide the required technical documents.

After their license suspensions and revocations, the telecoms operators shall settle any outstanding debts to MPTC and Telecommunication Regulator of Cambodia, public debts, private debts and other tax obligations. In addition, these 17 companies shall settle any claims by their employees, customers and related third parties in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in the event of disputes due to their license revocations.

Historically, MPTC notified all telecoms operators to comply with the Law on Telecommunications and relevant regulations in force. However, MPTC noticed that some operators still refused to comply or failed to fully comply with the Law on Telecommunications or license terms. As such, in the event that any telecoms operators choose to not comply with the Telecoms Law or abide by their license terms, such operators shall face the possibility of license suspension or revocation.

This announcement shall serve as guidance for all telecoms operators to fully comply with the Telecoms Law, regulations and license terms and as information for the general public.
