Cambodia, as Chair of ASEAN, will host the ASEAN Foreign Ministers' (AMM) Retreat, from 15 to 17 February 2022, in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, in a hybrid format. The Ministerial Retreat will be chaired by His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.

The AMM Retreat will follow-up on the leaders' decisions from the 38<sup>th</sup> and the 39<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summits, exchange views on how to further strengthen external relations with dialogue partners while maintaining and promoting ASEAN centrality, solidarity and unity, and discuss ways and means to collectively endeavour to build a more resilient, dynamic, peaceful and prosperous ASEAN Community. Regional and international issues of common interest and concern will also be discussed in the meeting.

His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn will brief the meeting on key deliverables to be achieved during Cambodia's Chairmanship under the theme «ASEAN A.C.T.: Addressing Challenges Together», in responding to the strategic challenges facing the region, including effective control of the Covid-19 pandemic and inclusive recovery process, geo-political rivalries, existing traditional and non-traditional issues, and strengthening ASEAN's cohesiveness, centrality and resilience.
