Minister Delegate OUCH Borith Highly Appreciates Cambodia-UN Cooperation,

Underlines Cambodia's Pride in Becoming the Main Contributor to UNPKOs

His Excellency OUCH Borith, Minister Delegate Attached to the Prime Minister and

Standing Secretary of State, had a meeting on 22 August with His Excellency Adbulla

Shahid, President of the 76th Session of the United Nations General Assembly and

concurrently the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Maldives, who was on

a working visit to the Kingdom of Cambodia on 21-22 August 2022.

H.E. Abdulla Shahid stressed that his visit, although short, underscored his

appreciation for Cambodia's commitment to multilateralism and its contribution to

maintaining peace and security in the region and the world. He was impressed to

see Cambodia's rapid development progress in all fields and commended

Cambodia's success in combatting the spread of covid-19, as well as steady

economic recovery from the pandemic.

Minister Delegate OUCH Borith expressed his high regard for the dedication and

tireless work of H.E. Adbulla Shahid's in his service as the UNGA President, during

the year of many daunting challenges confronting the world. He underscored the

importance of the consultations on the UN Secretary-General's report "Our Common

Goal ", in ensuring that United Nations refocuses on the priority to address the most

pressing global needs, including accelerating progress towards the sustainable

development agenda.

H.E. OUCH Borith highly appreciated the good cooperation between Cambodia and

the United Nations and thanked the UN and UN Country Team, particularly World

Health Organization, International Committee of the Red Cross and UNICEF for their

support in the fight against COVID-19, and for the UN assistance to the socio-

economic development in Cambodia. He also praised the good working relations between Cambodia and all 26 UN Agencies in the field of health, food security, environment, education and other various sectors.

While touching on Cambodia's Contribution to the UN Peace-Keeping Operations (UNPKOs), H.E. OUCH Borith and H.E. Adbulla Shahid underlined Cambodia's proud transformation from being a recipient country of the UN Peace Keepers in the 90s to a significant contributing country to the UN Peacekeeping Missions around the world. H.E. OUCH Borith highlighted that since 2006, Cambodia has dispatched 8,302 troops, including 580 women, to join 11 UN Peace Keeping Missions in 9 countries. The President of the 76<sup>th</sup> Session of the UNGA commended Cambodia exemplary contribution to the UNPKOs.

Apart from ASEAN-UN cooperation, H.E. Ouch Borith briefed H.E. Adbulla Shahid on the success conclusion of the 55<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Ministerial Meeting and Related Meetings, held from 30 July to 6 August 2022. Both sides touched on the possibility and coordination to have the 12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN-UN Summit, in concurrence with 40<sup>th</sup> and 41<sup>st</sup> ASEAN Summits and Related Summits in Nov 2022 in Cambodia.

H.E. OUCH Borith and H.E. Adbulla Shahid also discussed ways to further enhance Cambodia-Maldives bilateral relations, including through the exchange of top-level visits, consideration of an agreement on visa exemption between the two countries and the establishment of political consultations between the two Ministries of Foreign Affairs to explore potential areas for bilateral cooperation.
