OUTCOMES OF THE THIRD ROUND OF BILATERAL POLITICAL CONSULTATIONS BETWEEN CAMBODIA AND SWITZERLAND Held in Phnom Penh on 3rd February 2023

Phnom Penh, 04 February 2023 - On 03 February 2023, H.E. Dr. CHEM Widhya, Secretary of State of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, co-chaired the Third Round of the Bilateral Political Consultations between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Swiss Confederation with H.E. Ambassador Heinrich Schellenberg, Assistant State Secretary for Asia Pacific of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs of Switzerland, at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.

Both sides noted with high satisfaction of the traditional excellent bonds of friendship and close cooperation, which happily exist between the two countries. They gave an overview of the political and economic situations in their respective countries and went on to discuss bilateral relations covering political, development and economic dimensions. Discussions focused on wideranging areas of cooperation, including health, governance, decentralisation, agriculture, food security, trade, investment, tourism, vocational training, demining, development assistance and cooperation in international organisations, incuding at the United Nations and ASEAN-Switzerland Cooperation. The two sides shared strong commitments to build on those areas. They further exchanged views regional and international issues of common interest and concern.

H.E. Dr. CHEM Widhya expressed the deep gratitude of the Cambodian people to the Switzerland for the development assistance to Cambodia over the years, while hailing the magnificent work made by Kantha Bopha Hospital for Cambodian children and women.

To further boost the trade volume, he proposed the establishment of a business forum between the two countries' chambers of commerce and follow on the discussions to explore the possibility of establishing a free trade agreement between the two countries to diversify export markets.

The Third Round of the Bilateral Political Consultations between the two Foreign Ministries were held successfully in a cordial and fruitful atmosphere wich is impregnated by the excellent friendship that characterise the relations between Cambodia and Switzerland.

In addition, the two countries organized cultural performances event to celebrate the 60thAnniversary of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the Kingdom of Cambodia and Switzerland at the Chaktomuk Conference Hall. ENDS
