"Cambodia and Türkiye aim for two-way trade goal of USD one billion"

His Excellency SOK Chenda Sophea, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, held productive talks with Her Excellency Ülkü Kocaefe, Ambassador of the Republic of Türkiye, on 6 October 2023.

The two sides noted with satisfaction the cordial relations between the two countries as they prepare to celebrate the 65th anniversary of diplomatic relations next year. They expressed their readiness to jointly launch activities to commemorate this significant milestone between Cambodia and Türkiye. They also discussed ways to further strengthen the relationship and prioritize potential areas of cooperation in line with the Royal Government of Cambodia's Pentagonal Strategy - Phase 1.

On economic and trade ties, the two sides expressed deep appreciation over their close cooperation. They expressed their commitment to explore possibilities to increase commercial activities to achieve a two-way trade goal of USD one billion. Her Excellency Kocaefe noted that Türkiye had established an office of the commercial counsellor in Cambodia to better coordinate efforts to boost bilateral trade and investment.

The Deputy Prime Minister expressed his sincere gratitude to the Turkish government for its development assistance to Cambodia. The Ambassador reaffirmed her government's commitment to assist Cambodia, especially through the Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TİKA).

The two sides exchanged views on cooperation in the fields of culture, tourism and education, including scholarships and training for Cambodian diplomats and students. They also discussed cooperation under multilateral frameworks.
