

Youth-Led Project 2024 (YLP24 - Phase 1)

Phnom Penh

Open Development Cambodia Organization (ODC) is an 'open data' website, the first of its kind in Southeast Asia. The open data movement is based on the simple premise that data collected for public interest should be publicly available without restrictions. Information or data in the public domain should be freely available to everyone to use and republish as they wish. ODC does not promote any particular perspective, agenda, or bias other than to provide objective information about Cambodia and its development.

Introduction

Cambodia's future is dependent on its youth, who account for a sizable proportion of the population. Despite this, many young Cambodians are dealing with a variety of economic and social difficulties, including migration, gender-based violence, discrimination, and climate change effects. They frequently lack the skills, opportunity, and support required to make meaningful contributions to their communities. To overcome these issues, it is critical to increase young participation in community development projects. Governments and civil society groups must work together to offer the necessary assistance and opportunity for young people to contribute meaningfully to Cambodia's development.

Under the Social Lab Program funded by USAID, ODC will recruit youths, with a focus on marginalized groups including girls, youths with disabilities, indigenous youths, LGBTQI+ youths, and minority youths. These youths will undergo skill-building activities, receive a youth-led project, and engage in knowledge-sharing platforms over six months, with support from ODC staff. They will participate in three key Convening Moments organized by USAID Advancing Youth Leadership (AYL) partners. Equipped with skills and expertise, they will address community challenges related to climate change and digital issues, emphasizing social inclusion. The youths will lead their initiatives, showcasing their ability to drive positive change, particularly among marginalized groups. ODC will highlight the efforts through various channels, including its website, social media, workshops, and events. ODC will also involve youths in its activities to enhance their skills and knowledge, aiming to empower their employability and networking opportunities.

What is YLP24?

The Youth-Led Project 2024 (YLP24) brings together young people in Phnom Penh to solve community concerns while preparing for future professional opportunities.

YLP24 will be six months with a **stipend**, **training**, **and coaching** on fundamental life skills, data literacy, and project management. This will equip the youths to be effective leaders.

The youths are expected to participate in the series of training and three Convening Moments (CMs) hosted in Phnom Penh.



Objective of YLP24

- The selected youths have strengthened their capacity for fundamental life and community development skills through various training and knowledge sharing as demonstrated during convening moments.
- The youths' experiences and perspectives are empowered based on community development skills through practical action experiences and competent project implementation.

Role of Participants

The youths are committed to joining the six-month program including a series of training, three convening moments, and a youth-led project.

The program is precisely designed to empower participants by developing their leadership qualities and enhancing critical skills required for effective community participation, so unlocking their full leadership potential.

Participants will learn about project management and community engagement, among other topics, through a carefully designed set of training sessions.

The program provides a unique opportunity for participants to communicate with peers or teams, fostering cross-dialogue and providing vital insights gleaned from varied views.

- Learn new skills and knowledge in **fundamental life skills**, **data literacy**, **and project management**
- Receive a **USD\$ 35 monthly stipends** for local transportation
- Expand your **leadership mindset and skill**

Who can join YLP24?

- Youths living in **Phnom Penh**
- Preferably **aged 18-25** at the time of application, (Girls, youths with disabilities, indigenous youths, LGBTQI+ youths, and minority youths are encouraged to join)
- Want to grow their leadership, digital literacy, and project management skills
- **Be committed** to participating in the whole program (six months)
- Passionate about working on the youth-led project

- 4. Shortlisted applicants will be contacted for a pre-workshop on 21st May 2024
- 5. The final participant list will be announced on **22nd May 2024**
- 6. The successful candidate has to join the first Convening Moment (CM) on the **25**th **26**th **of May**, the second CM in **June**, and the third CM in **September 2024**.
