United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS for the Term 2026-2028"**

The Kingdom of Cambodia is honored to announce its re-election as a member of the Program Coordinating Board (PCB) of the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS) representing the Asia-Pacific Region for the 2026-2028 term, beginning on 1 January 2026. This decision, made during the 22<sup>nd</sup> Plenary Meeting of the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) on 10 June 2025 in New York, marks a significant milestone.
