Announcement

The Cambodian Human Rights Committee (CHRC) wishes to inform the public that, according to a report by *Khaosod English* dated 12 October 2025, Thai Senator Mrs. Angkhana Neelapaijit made remarks in reference to CHRC's urgent appeal submitted to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) concerning the use of disturbing sounds as a form of psychological intimidation and harassment along the Cambodia–Thailand border by members of the Thai military dated 11 October 2025.

The CHRC would like to quote the following excerpt:

“The government should be aware that any action that instills fear or affects the mental well-being of civilians, even those in a conflict, especially vulnerable groups, may constitute Psychological Torture under the CAT Convention, to which Thailand is a party. Senator Angkhana Neelapaijit urges the Thai Foreign Ministry to look into the blurring of ghost sounds by a Thai social media influencer across the Thai border into Cambodia.”
