**Outcomes of the Extended Informal Consultation
on the Implementation of the Five-Point Consensus
24 October 2025, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia**

On 24 October 2025, at the invitation of His Excellency Dato' Seri Utama Haji Mohamad bin Haji Hasan, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, attended the Extended Informal Consultation on the Implementation of the Five-Point Consensus (5PC) in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

The Ministers commended Malaysia's proactive and able leadership under His Excellency Anwar Ibrahim, Prime Minister of Malaysia, and appreciated the efforts of the Special Envoy of the ASEAN Chair on Myanmar in facilitating inclusive dialogue, urging the cessation of violence, and enhancing the delivery of humanitarian assistance, particularly in the wake of the devastating earthquake earlier this year.

His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister PRAK Sokhonn reiterated Cambodia's firm commitment to supporting ASEAN's collective efforts in advancing the implementation of the 5PC and helping Myanmar resolve its crisis through a political process that is led and owned by Myanmar. He also reaffirmed the importance of the ASEAN Troika and Extended Troika mechanisms as well as other innovative proposals to ensure continuity, promote consistency and synergy, and maintain a positive momentum.

Additionally, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister held a bilateral meeting with His Excellency Dato' Seri Utama Haji Mohamad Bin Haji Hasan, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, during which he expressed sincere gratitude to Malaysia for providing good offices and tireless efforts in helping Cambodia and Thailand to peacefully resolve their border dispute. His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister expressed his congratulations on Malaysia's successful Chairmanship of ASEAN this year. Both Ministers also touched upon the deepening of bilateral cooperation, agreeing to hold 3rd Joint Commission for Bilateral Cooperation between Cambodia and Malaysia in 2026 in Malaysia.
