**Royal Embassy of Cambodia and Tokyo Metropolitan Government
Explore City-Level Cooperation**

H.E. Mr. CHUM Sounry, Ambassador-Designate of Cambodia to Japan, held a meeting on 8 January 2026 with senior officials of the Tokyo Metropolitan Government led by Mr. KUWABARA Atsushi, Special Advisor to the Governor for International Affairs, during which the two sides exchanged views on strengthening cooperation between Cambodia and Tokyo at the city level. Ambassador-Designate Sounry expressed appreciation for Tokyo's leadership in promoting sustainable urban development and welcomed continued engagement to enhance friendship and cooperation between Cambodia and Japan.

The Ambassador conveyed Cambodia's strong interest in engaging with the **Global City Network for Sustainability (G-NETS)** as a complementary platform for cooperation, noting the potential participation of major Cambodian cities such as Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, and Sihanoukville. Both sides recognized the value of cooperation in areas including sustainability, climate resilience, mobility, and smart-city development, and expressed readiness to maintain close coordination, including in the context of Cambodia's prospective engagement in the 3rd G-NETS Summit to be hosted by Japan in April 2026, with a view to advancing practical and mutually beneficial city-to-city cooperation.

Both sides underscored the importance of maintaining close coordination and communication to advance practical and mutually beneficial cooperation. The meeting reflected the shared commitment of Cambodia and Japan to promoting people-to-people ties and supporting the broader Cambodia–Japan Comprehensive Strategic Partnership through enhanced local-level and city-based collaboration.
