



Visa exemption for Chinese tourists for a period of four months

(Effective for the period from 15 June 2026 to 15 October 2026)

The Ministry of Tourism has the honor to inform the public, tourism industry associations, tourism operators, the private sector, media representatives, domestic and international tourists, and all relevant stakeholders that, with the high approval of Samdech Moha Borvor Thipadei Hun Manet, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Royal Government of Cambodia has authorized a visa exemption for Chinese nationals holding passports of the People's Republic of China (PRC), including Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau, excluding Taiwan. Regardless of whether they travel directly from China or from any other country, all holders of PRC passports entering the Kingdom of Cambodia shall be granted visa exemption and permitted to stay in Cambodia for 14 days, during a period of 4 months, from 15 June 2026 to 15 October 2026, without any requirement to submit a visa application or pay any fees, provided that travelers complete the E-Arrival Card. During the implementation period, Chinese tourists may enter Cambodia multiple times as they wish.

In light of the above, the Ministry of Tourism respectfully calls upon the public, tourism industry associations, tourism operators, the private sector, media representatives, domestic and international tourists, and all relevant stakeholders to take note of and jointly implement this measure with a high sense of responsibility, as well as to actively disseminate and promote it widely through all means and in all forms, with a view to further increasing the number of Chinese tourists visiting the Kingdom of Cambodia.
