Notice of Response

To Cambodia Travel Advisory

Issued by Certain Foreign Missions in the Kingdom of Cambodia

The Ministry of Tourism of the Kingdom of Cambodia would like to express appreciation for the sharing information regarding travel advisories to Cambodia and the recently published maps by foreign embassies accredited to the Kingdom of Cambodia. Regarding the previously disseminated information and maps, these may have caused misunderstanding among the public and tourists, particularly international tourists, about the overall tourism safety situation in Cambodia. The heightened precautions mentioned apply only to certain border areas and cannot be generalized about the overall safety and security situation throughout the entire Kingdom of Cambodia. In this regard, the Ministry of Tourism would like to reaffirm that the Kingdom of Cambodia remains a **safe, secure, and stable** tourism destination for both national and international tourists. Major tourist destinations, including Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, Preah Sihanouk, and other tourism sites, continue to operate normally and remain fully open to warmly welcome visitors, with safety and security duly ensured.

The Ministry of Tourism has always been open to cooperation and to providing tourism-related information and factual updates to ensure that disseminated information is accurate, balanced, and supportive of international tourists' decision-making regarding their travel plans to Cambodia in a safe manner.

In light of the above, the Ministry of Tourism calls upon the public, foreign diplomatic missions in Cambodia, national and international media, tourists, and all relevant stakeholders to take note and to participate in disseminating information with a high sense of responsibility.
