**Diplomatic Corps Visit to Border Areas of Pursat Province**

On 27 March 2026, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister PRAK Sokhonn, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, led a site visit to the Cambodia–Thailand border at Thmor Da Commune, Veal Veng District, Pursat Province, with the participation of members of the diplomatic corps and representatives of international organizations accredited to the Kingdom of Cambodia.

The delegation visited 76 displaced Cambodian families who have been living in makeshift shelters at Hun Sen Pramaoy High School of Veal Veng District since the fighting in December 2025 and are still unable to return to their homes in the area currently under illegal occupation by Thai forces.

The delegation subsequently proceeded to observe the situation in the area of Chey Chumneah border checkpoint in Thmor Da Commune, where Thai military personnel have placed barbed wire and shipping containers, including three additional ones installed on 26 March 2026, blocking National Road 55 and restricting access to the homes and lands of the displaced residents.

His Excellency the Deputy Prime Minister underscored that the Royal Government of Cambodia remains firmly committed to resolving all border issues through peaceful means, in accordance with international law and relevant bilateral agreements, while remaining resolute in upholding Cambodia’s principled position that borderlines must not be changed by force.
