
Kratie Province





I. Introduction to the Province

Kratie Province is located in the northeast region of Cambodia. From the national capital, Phnom Penh, Kratie can be accessed via National Road No.7 passing through Snoul district (230 km), National Road No.7 passing through Dam Be and Chhlong district (250 km), and via waterway, the Mekong river (220 km), which runs through Kratie city and 4 other districts for a total of 140 km.

The Province shares a border with Vietnam, and bilateral trade with Vietnam is active and has potential for further expansion. Kratie province is comprised of one provincial city, 5 districts (Chhlong, Prek Prasorb, Sambo, Snoul, and Chet Borey district), 41 communes and 250 villages with 81.42% of the population being farmers.

Kratie province has a total area of 11,094 km², which divides into 2 specific regions; the northeast and southwest. Northeast segment of the province is a plateau region consisting mainly of thick forests, a variety of grasses and fertile red soil, which are favorable to livestock rearing, and agro-industry plantations such as rubber, pepper, and cashew nuts.

Southwest segment is mostly wet plains that are typical to Cambodia and consist of highly fertile soils especially along the Mekong river that are favorable to agricultural crops such as rice, corn, and bean. In addition, these wet plains are home to a group of rare Irrawaddy dolphins and other fish species. The dolphins are the main tourist attraction for the province and Kratie City.

6) Special features or strong points for the Province in terms of investment

- > Abundant natural resources to expand agro-industry, livestock and rubber plantations including Economic Land Concession.
- Advantageous location bordering with Vietnam for expanding bilateral trade, particularly for the export of agricultural products.
- Large potential for the construction of large-scale hydro-power plants for increasing the electricity supply capacity.
- > Irrawaddy dolphins, which attract tourist to the Province.
- Rich mining resources such as gold and stone.
- > Two industrial sites located at Snoul district for future commercial and industrial zone development.

7) Investment opportunities or potential sector

Industry: rubber latex and rubber tree processing, cassava processing plants, sugar plantation/production and ethanol production plants

Mining: Gold mining and stone quarrying.

Tourism: Cultural sites, eco-tourism, Mekong river and surrounding small islands, and rare Irrawaddy dolphins.

Agriculture: Rice paddy, agro-industry plantations such as rubber, cassava, cashew nut, corn and jatropha.

Economic Land Concessions: Agro-industry, particularly rubber plantations, for a total of 32,705 ha.

There are two industrial sites designated by the province for future development into commercial and industrial zones. The two development areas are located in Pi-Thnou Commune, Snoul District

Sambo district: 467 KW to 3.3 MW

11) Reasons or Measures for Promotion of the Priority Industries

- > Total cassava plantation land is 32,003 ha with production amounting to 800,075 tons per year at present though farmer's income still has not increased due to weak competitiveness in international market due to the fact that most cassava is exported in a raw, unprocessed form. The establishment of cassava processing plants will add value to current production and has the potential of developing new potential in the international market.
- > Generating electricity by using sugar and ethanol is expected to solve the current shortage of electricity power supply as well as the high cost of electricity in the province.
- > Irrawaddy dolphins are the main tourist attraction for the province and Kratie City.
